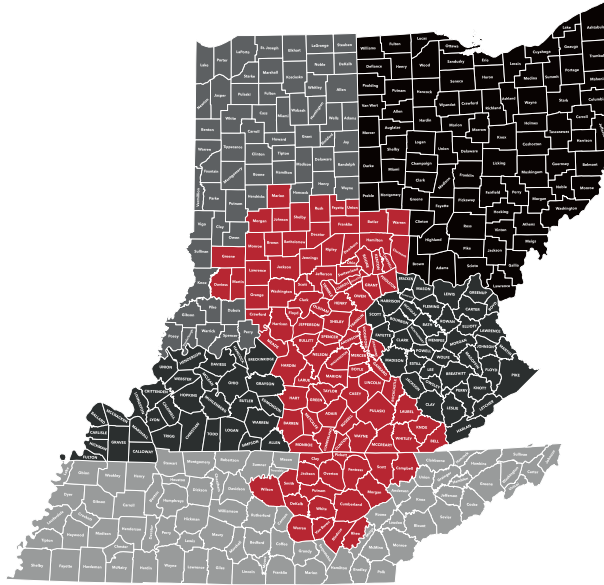

Residential Heating Oil Tanks

Residential heating oil tanks store fuel oil to provide space heating on a property used primarily for dwelling purposes. With proper tank management, spills and leaks can be avoided. Routinely inspect your tank before every fill using the checklist in this pamphlet.

How do I know if I have a leak?

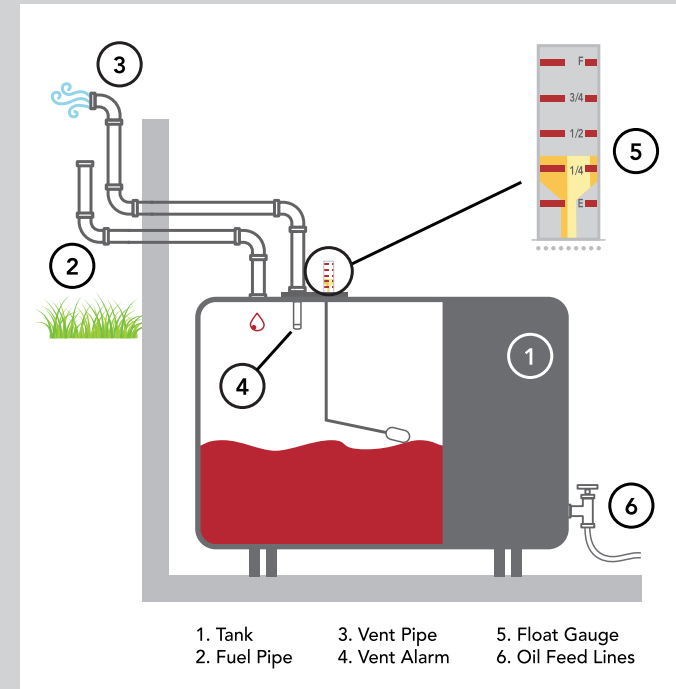
- Soil is saturated with heating oil
- Soil or other surface material is stained
- Vapors are present in the soil or basement
- Fuel is observed in the basement, a stream, an underground utility line, etc
- Oil consumption has suddenly increased
- Furnace is operating erratically

What do I do if I have a leak?

- Turn off the tank and remove any sources of flames/sparks near the area
- If odors are in the house, ventilate affected areas, and close off unaffected areas
- Stop or contain the release - absorbent material like cat litter, sawdust, or newspaper can be used to stop the release from spreading
- Keep children and pets away
- Contact your local fire department
- Call us! Emergency line is available 24/7

SELF-INSPECTION CHECKLIST FOR HEATING OIL TANKS

- **Do you see rust, weeps, wet spots, or holes on the tank's surface?**
- **Does the oil line run either under concrete or above ground without a protective coating?**
- **Are there any threats of snow or ice falling on the oil tank or the filter?**
- **Are there any signs that the vent line is clogged by ice, snow, or other debris such as spider or bee nests?**
- **Is the overfill vent whistle obstructed, or silent when the tank is being filled?**
- **Are there any signs of spills around the fill pipe?**
- **Is the tank gauge cracked, stuck, or frozen?**
- **Do you see oil or staining around the tank gauge?**
- **Are the tank legs rusted, unstable, or on an uneven foundation?**
- **If the answer is YES to any of the above questions, call an oil burner technician for a more detailed inspection and corrective measures.**



SYSTEM CHANGES

Contact us immediately if you change heating systems, remove your heating oil tank from basement, or upgrade tank or line equipment. This will ensure a fuel delivery is not made to a tank no longer in service or through an interior basement line that has been disconnected.
